

GENERAL WIRING DIAGRAM



WARNING

- TURN OFF ELECTRICAL POWER AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE WIRING FIXTURE TO THE POWER SUPPLY.
- TURN OFF THE POWER WHEN YOU PERFORM ANY MAINTENANCE.
- VERIFY THAT SUPPLY VOLTAGE IS CORRECT BY COMPARING IT WITH THE LUMINAIRE LABEL INFORMATION.
- ALL WIRING CONNECTIONS SHOULD BE CAPPED WITH UL APPROVED WIRE CONNECTORS.


CAUTION

- AVOID DIRECT EYE EXPOSURE TO THE LIGHT SOURCE WHILE IT IS ON.
- ACCOUNT FOR SMALL PARTS AND DESTROY PACKING MATERIAL, AS THESE MAY BE HAZARDOUS TO CHILDREN.
- **RISK OF BURN.** DISCONNECT POWER AND ALLOW FIXTURE TO COOL BEFORE CHANGING BULB OR HANDLING FIXTURE.


NOTICE

- SUITABLE FOR DRY OR DAMP LOCATION.


INSTALLATION (ALWAYS TURN OFF THE POWER SUPPLY FROM MAIN CIRCUIT BREAKER FIRST!)




1. Bend out mounting tab 90° on each corner of the fixture.




2. Use side cutters tools to adjust each tab to height of T-grid.




3. Lay fixture into T-grid.




4. Bend tabs flush against T-grid in order to clear corner for ceiling tile.



5. Use a #8x1/4" sheet metal screw to fasten fixture to T-grid. Use a hanger wire to tie off appropriately in accordance with local building codes (screws and hanger wires not provided).



6. Make sure all electrical connections are properly connected. Attach the wiring access cover plate.



- DIP switches are located onto the drive box.
- Select a wattage and color temperature by sliding switch left or right respectively to the desired value.
